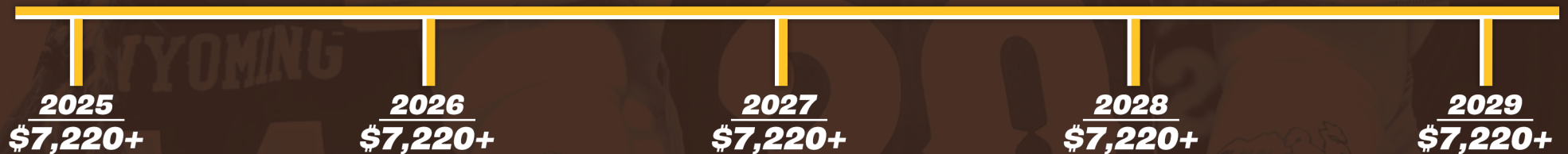
WELCOME TO THE 7220 SOCIETY
